

Snorkeling with Salt Cay Divers

What to Expect

Snorkel tours are guided by our dive shop staff to explore remote islands, beautiful reefs and marine life. Snorkel tours vary in duration.

Please note that snorkeling in open ocean waters is a physically demanding activity, and we require guests to have basic snorkeling experience, and in good physical shape. Introductory or refresher snorkel experiences are an option for our guests as well.

Our Trips

- Gibb's Cay
 - 3-hour snorkel tour to a remote sandy beach that is inhabited by Southern sting rays. Guests have the unique opportunity to snorkel with wild rays in crystal clear, shallow water. (Minimum 4 snorkelers).
- Cotton Cay
 - Salt Cay Divers has exclusive permission to take passengers on a special 3-hour excursion to this private island, where we enjoy some of the best snorkeling in the Turks Islands. Guided eco-tour of the island to observe marine life, Turks & Caicos history, birds and plants unique to this island. (Minimum 4 snorkelers).
- Great Sand Cay
 - 3-hour snorkel excursion to a protected wildlife sanctuary. This island features beautiful marine life and a pristine island, which serves as a seabird and turtle nesting site.
- Salt Cay
 - 2-3 hour snorkel around various north and west locations surrounding Salt Cay, featuring large coral heads, a wide variety of reef fish, turtles, sharks, and conch. Land-based snorkeling in Salt Cay is another great option, with several easily accessible beaches.

What is included

- Water, beverages, snacks
- Snorkel equipment (bring your own or options to rent)
- Snorkel vests

What to bring

- Sunscreen (preferably Reef-Safe)
- Beach Towel
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Water bottle
- Swimsuit and cover-up, rashguard (close fitting top for swimming, snorkeling or diving)
- Personal camera
- Motion sickness medicine (if needed)

We ask you to meet us at the dive shop at least 15 minutes prior the scheduled time of departure. If you are planning on having lunch at the Coral Reef Bar in between tours, please place your order before departure.

Morning and afternoon excursion times vary, depending on guest demand, availability, and weather conditions.
