Whale Watching with Salt Cay Divers

What to Expect

3-hour whale watch in any direction around Salt Cay. Every tour is unique, as the humpback whales exhibit a wide variety of behaviours during their annual breeding migration, including singing, resting, nursing, breaching, and travelling.

There is a possibility of getting in the water to snorkel with whales, which depends on whale behaviours and weather conditions. Although it can be a very exciting occasion, all whale encounters will adhere to the current regulations protecting this endangered species.

What is Included

- Water, beverages, snacks
- Snorkel equipment (or bring your own)
- Snorkel vests
- Hydrophone

What to Bring

- Sunscreen (preferably Reef-Safe)
- Beach Towel
- Hat
- Water bottle
- Swimsuit and cover-up
- Sunglasses
- Personal camera
- Motion sickness medicine (if needed)
