
HOW TO HAVE A SAFE, ENJOYABLE WHALE ENCOUNTER

Whether you're on the boat or in the water, always keep an eye and ear out for the captain's instructions




APPROACH QUIETLY AND CALMLY

Disturbances and loud noises will make it less likely that the whales will stick around. You can reduce noise by sliding into the water instead of jumping and swimming sideways

KEEP A RESPECTFUL DISTANCE

To give yourself the best possible view and keep the whales comfortable, stay at least 30 feet away from the whales when in the water, and position yourself so the whales can see you





DON'T DIVE BELOW THE SURFACE

It is vital that the captain is able to see you at all times when you're in the water, and it is also important that we infringe as little as possible on the whales' environment.
